

Freeze Guarding Procedures

- 1. Drain the water-box, then close the drain valve when empty.
- 2. Pour 1-2 gal of unmixed green antifreeze into the water-box.
- 3. Connect a solution hose with an open end, to the solution outlet of the unit, and return the open end to the water-box to recirculate the antifreeze throughout the system. This will mix with the existing water in the system.
- 4. Disconnect the incoming water supply hose from the inlet on the front panel.
- 5. Start the unit up, leave the engine speed at idle, turn on the solution pump, and let circulate for 10 minutes.
- 6. Empty out chemical jug, or store indoors, and place the chemical draw hose into a jug of unmixed antifreeze. Set chemical setting to prime, to prime the chemical pump, then set selector to on to fill the flow meter.
- 7. Turn off machine, disconnect hoses, and remove PSI gauge since it will not be protected with normal freeze guarding.
- 8. You now have successfully freeze guarded your truckmount. All remaining tools, solution hoses, water softeners, and freezable product should be brought indoors.
